Gerry Koning, a member of the Classis Vision Team, explained that the process that we are going through today of examining a candidate to be loaned to a Reformed Church in America Church on a first call is a very unique situation. Koning has been in close contact with the denomination's Office of Candidacy and others, to make sure that this is the correct procedure.

III. Classical Exam

Article 4

A. Introduction of Candidate Shelby Gemmen, Rev. Bob Huisman:

Rev. Huisman related that a couple of years ago when Immanuel CRC was going through the Renewal Lab, they hired Gemmen to be their intern. This led to a growing mentorship as he watched Gemmen prepare for the ministry.

B. Proper procedure:

- Motion was made by Immanuel CRC to loan Candidate Shelby
 Gemmen to the Grant Reformed Church upon successful completion
 of his classical exam. Question was raised about Gemmen's salary and
 pension, and all were assured that Grant Reformed Church is
 responsible for these. Motion was seconded and carried. The
 Synodical Deputies concurred with this motion.
- 2. Rev. Tom Kragt conducted the practical exam. This was followed by a motion to proceed which was MSC.
- 3. Rev. Jeff Scripps reported favorably on the sermon that was preached on the previous Sunday at Grant Reformed Church. <u>Motion was MSC to proceed. The Synodical Deputies concurred with this decision.</u>
- 4. Rev. Stan Drenth presided over the theological exam. Motion was made to accept Candidate Gemmen into the ministry of the Word and Sacraments in the Christian Reformed Church.
- 5. Executive session is declared (visitors are excused). Motion is to be voted on by paper ballot. After a brief discussion and ballots counted, motion was seconded and carried to accept Candidate Gemmen into the ministry of the Word and Sacraments in the Christian Reformed Church. The Synodical Deputies gave their concurrence to classis' decision.
