Fairway CRC's requests that Classis Georgetown approve the use of church order Article 24(b) to call Jeremy Rhodes to become a Commissioned Pastor of Fairway Christian Reformed Church for a term of three years. This will allow him time to complete the EPMC training within a three-year timeframe.

Article 24b.

Commissioned pastors may be called to a position in which the call is for a specified term contingent upon accountable progress toward completion of the requirements for ordination as a minister of the Word. Approval of the classis, with the concurrence of synodical deputies, is required as to the terms of such a call and the accountability of progress in the proposed learning plan.

Fairway also requests that Classis Georgetown grant permission for Jeremy Rhodes to serve as stated supply until he can be examined by Classis Georgetown to become a commissioned pastor.

- d) Extension of Ministerial Credentials (Executive Session)
