3.1 Council of Delegates Report – Ms. Jeanne Kallemeyn

The COD met from May 7-9 in Grand Rapids. One item of note from Resonate Global Mission: While the value for church multiplication continues, Resonate's role in how it supports church plants is shifting. Rather than financing church plants directly, Resonate will invest in training, coaching, and assessment to equip church planters for long-term success, relying on local partnerships from other churches in the Classis to provide ongoing financial support. Jeanne is thanked for her work on our behalf.

3.2 Classical Ministry Leadership Team (CMLT) Report – Rev. Jeffery Scripps
One student has applied for aid for the MDiv program at Calvin Seminary.

MOTION: To approve \$9,348 in aid for Mr. Samuel Kuipers for the MDiv program at Calvin Seminary from September 2025-August 2026.

Rev. Ron Bouwkamp, a volunteer representative from ReFrame Ministries shares about the media ministry of our denomination. It extends far beyond what anyone can expect and Rev. Bouwkamp expresses gratitude for seeds that are planted. Rev. Bouwkamp is thanked for sharing this report.

3.5 Rev. Gale Tien leads in a prayer of thanks for the work and ministry of our Classis and denominational leaders, giving thanks for how we work together and asking for discernment in where God is leading us as we serve Him together.

Article 4: WE CELEBRATE OUR VALUE OF RISKY COMPASSION

- 4.1 As we focus on our classis value of Risky Compassion, Rev. Jeremy Rhodes welcomes Ms. Jodi Joseph, Executive Director of Hand2Hand Ministries.
- Ms. Joseph shares about the work of Hand2Hand, a ministry that feeds children physically and spiritually. 1 in 7 kids in West Michigan are at risk of hunger and Hand2Hand delivers food to students over the weekend and during school beaks a time when children are most vulnerable to hunger. It began in 2008 with one school, one church, and 19 students and now reaches over 15,000 students in 280 schools and has the support of 145 churches. She encourages all present to become involved and partner with Hand2Hand.
