

Classis Georgetown Clergy Health and Flourishing Initiative Funding Application

Background

In 2024, the Vision Team of Classis Georgetown recognized an opportunity in the face of declining student fund requests and a growing student fund. Building on the continuing education encouragement values expressed by Synod 2000¹ and 2016², the Vision Team developed the *Clergy Health and Flourishing Initiative* for Classis Georgetown Pastors. This proposal was approved by the Vision Team in August 2024 and approved by Classis over the course of two meetings³.

Summary

Classis Georgetown affirmed the Synodical values that congregations and pastors benefit when pastor are continually learning and professionally growing. Classis Georgetown approved four recommendations related to Clergy Health and Betterment:

1. Classis will annually financially support up to 75% of the costs of an accredited CPE program for Classis Georgetown Pastors.
2. Classis will annually provide up to \$2500 for pastors to participate in *conferences, seminars or coaching* after a congregation has invested \$2500 in its pastor's continuing education efforts.
3. Classis will provide up to \$2500 for Pastors' sabbaticals after a congregation has invested at least \$3500 in its pastor's sabbatical (these funds are to be applied to learning opportunities or expenses related to the Pastor's sabbatical, not for staffing, pulpit supply, or administrative costs in the pastor's absence).
4. Classis affirmed the value of congregations and councils encouraging their pastor(s) to nourish good physical, emotional, and spiritual health strategies.

¹ Synod 2000 established a policy that all councils should develop a Continuing Education policy for its ministry staff (20 hours per week or more) as a means to encourage ongoing, professional development. The components included \$1200 annually and 10 days annually (not included in vacation time). www.crcna.org/sites/default/files/continuinged.pdf

² Synod 2016 approved a "far-reaching new initiative for continuing education for pastors."
